

We sent the following letter to people who have supported Wine n Wags by buying tickets, donating auction items and/or money, and purchasing auction items . We know that your joining our list of subscribers is profound evidence of your love of animals and want to be sure you are aware of our funding campaign and apologize if you are receiving our appeal twice. Thank you for helping us continue our mission!

Like most, Friends of White County Animals, a non-profit, volunteer based organization has been greatly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. In accordance with continued social distancing guidelines, our signature fundraising event, Wine N Wags, was cancelled. We exhausted all possible solutions; however, out of concern for the health and safety of our participants, sponsors, and volunteers, we feel this difficult decision reflects our current reality. Our Wine N Wags sponsors, Airflow Heating and Cooling, Essentials Salon and Spa, Payless Family Pharmacy, Rick Lee State Farm Insurance, Sparta Vet Services, and Speck Family Electric have agreed to donate their sponsor fees despite having cancellation of the event. These contributions have allowed us to continue to provide services that are needed now more than ever.

Our work is ongoing even in these difficult times, and we are grateful for the financial donations and volunteer effort that have made our mission of education and pet retention possible with the following services this year:

- The FWCA Food Bank which will distribute 40,000 lbs of food this year.
- FWCA stocks a Pet Food Bank at UCHRA for cat and dog food.
- Ongoing provision for the Emergency Veterinary Fund with Sparta Vet Services to assist those who provide good pet homes but cannot afford unexpected emergency vet care.
- Teaming with White County Humane Society in spaying, neutering of the growing population of unwanted or homeless cats with no shelter or rescue provisions in White County.
- The FWCA Kindness to Animals curriculum implemented in after-school programs
- Distance learning sessions with The Elephant Sanctuary and classroom visits to talk with students about animal welfare.
- The ongoing partnership of FWCA with the special education class at White County High School, and Boy Scout Troop No. 128 to repackage food for distribution while teaching about animal welfare and pet retention
- The provision of Pet Resuscitation Mask Kits to local K9 officers and all 10 county fire stations
- The distribution of packaged dog treats for 14 local drive-thru locations, providing 1000-1400 treats per month
